

## GEN 1.5 AIRCRAFT INSTRUMENTS, EQUIPMENT AND FLIGHT DOCUMENTS

### 1 General

Commercial Air Transport aircraft operating in the Republic of Maldives must adhere to the provisions of ICAO Annex 6 - *Operation of Aircraft, Part I - International Commercial Air Transport, Aeroplanes*, Chapter 6, (Airplane Instruments, Equipment and Flight Documents) and chapter 7 (Airplane Communication and Navigation Equipment).

### 2 Equipment to be carried by all types of flights

- 2.1 An aircraft shall not fly within Male' FIR unless it is so equipped with including radio and radio navigation equipment so as to comply with the law of the country in which the aircraft is registered and to enable communications to be made, the aircraft to be navigated, markings to be displayed and signals to be made in accordance with the Civil Aviation Regulations of the Republic of Maldives.

### 3 Equipment to be carried on all internal and on certain flights

- 3.1 On all internal flights a TSO-C129 standard GPS has to be installed.
- 3.2 Details of equipment related to different operations is given in Maldivian Airworthiness Requirements (MAR) Series "C" 9.

### 4 Flight documentation to be carried

An aircraft engaged in international operations shall carry:

- a) its certificate of registration;
- b) its certificate of airworthiness;
- c) the licence in respect of the radio station (if any)
- d) the licences of the members of the flight crew.
- e) one copy of such certificate of maintenance review as is in force; and
- f) the technical log.
- g) the operations manual if required.
- h) one copy of the load sheet if required.
