## **AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE**

No. CAD/DO-228/22 12 March 1996

#### **APPLICABILITY**

Dornier aircraft Model - 228 Serial Nos: all

#### **SUBJECT**

Brake housing assembly, Part number 5007279

#### **REFERENCE**

None

#### **REASONS**

A recent accident was caused by the fatigue failure of the subject assembly, which occurred in the torque-take-out cavity. The failure of the housing assembly led to the loss of hydraulic fluid, which in turn caused the loss of steering and brakes and the aircraft struck a light post causing substantial

Failure of the subject housing had also been experienced in other instances in the past.

Early detection of cracks could preclude subsequent failure and prevent accidents.

#### **ACTION AND COMPLIANCE**

Operators are required to carry out crack detection using dye penetrant at every annual inspection and using eddy current every 2000 landings. Evidence of cracks must be reported to the Civil Aviation Department without delay.

### **EFFECTIVITY**

This Directive becomes effective on 12 March 1996.
