CHANGES TO IATA TTBS: MALDIVES AIRPORT FEE – BQ

1.0 GENERAL

- 1.1 The provisions and application of the 10th amendment to Law Number 71/78, revising the Airport Service Charge had been notified vide Air Transport Circular AT 03/09 – Issue 01 dated 09 December 2009.

Subsequently, International Air Transport Association (IATA) has made the necessary amendments to Maldives Airport Fee – BQ and updated the Ticket Tax Box Service (TTBS) database to facilitate the collection of the revised Airport Services Charge at point of sale.

2.0 PURPOSE

- 2.1 The purpose of this Circular is to advise airlines and airport authorities of the changes made by IATA to TTBS database with regard to Maldives Airport Fee (BQ).

3.0 REQUIREMENT

- 3.1 Airlines operating international flights to/from Maldives and airport authorities are advised to take note of the following changes made to IATA TTBS: Maldives - Airport Fee – BQ;

- 4.1** This Circular supersedes Air Transport Circular No. 69-CA-C/CIR/2003/04 dated 17 April 2003.
