## **I Purpose of this NPRM**

This NPRM is to consult the industry before issuing the initial issue of ASC 139-9 – Procedure for the Reporting of Tall Structures.

## **2 Background to the Proposal**

ASC 139-9, Procedure for the Reporting of Tall Structures is issued because the CAA has identified a need to have information on tall structures available for publication on aeronautical charts.

The CAA ANS & Aerodromes Section has been assigned the task of maintaining a database of tall structures, the top measurement of which is 30 metres or more above ground level (within 15 kilometres of an aerodrome).

ASC 139-9 Initial Issue becomes effective on 31 January 2014.
